




# K'ayáchtn (Welcome)

Mosquito Creek Marina (MCM) is situated on Eslha7áń, one of 23 Skwxwú7mesh villages scattered throughout the Nation's 6,732 square kilometers of traditional territory. The land and waters bear witness to the rich history of Skwxwú7mesh ancestors, with some of these village sites dating back 3,000 years.




Demolition and repairs of docks, piles and breakwater **December 2024 to February 2025**

Nch'kaý and Mosquito Creek Marina are committed to removing infrastructure and remediating the marina in the most environmentally sustainable ways possible.

We have hired Legacy Environmental to oversee the removal of the docks, piles, and any other decommissioned infrastructure. They ensure we have all required permits and are following all Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) regulations.

An environmental monitor will be on site at all times during marine work.








### What's happening with the breakwater?

To reduce water movement within the marina, enhancements will be made to the existing east breakwater.


